

Progressive Education Center Tentative Summer Schedule 2013

8 Weeks: June 17 through August 10 (including holidays)

Upper Elementary/Middle School Summer Program (5th-8th Grade), Wed/Fri 8 am-3 pm: The elementary and middle school summer programs will provide a fun and friendly learning environment for your child. The summer program is designed for students to become better critical thinkers, speakers, and writers. Students will develop and practice their skills through various subjects such as math, science/health, art, and various styles of writing.

Detailed Course Descriptions:

SAT I Math/Verbal Courses, 2-8 hrs/wk (HS): Students will practice test-taking skills needed to master the SAT exam. The course will guide students on how to study for the exam, and to strategize for maximum scores. Students will practice problems and receive homework to understand their mistakes and see test patterns. There will be two full practice exams taken during the weekday classes.

Advanced Algebra 2, Chemistry, Geometry, Physics, Pre-Calculus, 4 hrs/wk per each subject (HS): Each course will provide an overview of key concepts to help students succeed in the subject during the regular school year. Exposure to subject fundamentals will contribute to students' further understanding of the subject. There is a curriculum workbook required for each course.

Persuasive Writing/Public Speaking, 2 hrs/wk (EL/MS/HS): These courses will teach students how to write persuasive essays/speeches and how to deliver them effectively and confidently. Students will compose persuasive essays and speeches in class. Each session requires students to practice and perform their written work in class. At the end of the course, students may receive a certificate of achievement.

Math: Pre-Algebra/Algebra 1, 4 hrs/wk (EL/MS): Students will strengthen their number sense through games and projects of foundational mathematical concepts.

Science/Diet and Health, 4 hrs/wk (EL/MS): This course will allow students to explore their curiosities about ourselves and the world we live in. Students will become scientists and concoct hypotheses and solutions to various scientific topics and projects. They will practice writing and recording their findings in lab reports.

Writing Style Exploration/Art/Creative Writing, 2 hrs/wk (EL/MS): This course is designed for students to strengthen their writing skills and learn to express themselves through art and creative writing. The course will allow students to develop skills to write with more detail and cohesion. At the end of the course, students will have written a book, created pieces of art and poetry, and feel more confident in writing.
